INTRODUCTION

Dear Friends,

After a decade, TUM is nowadays ready to celebrate its 10th edition, on April 2022.

In the last ten years, we worked to improve and sharpen the technologies for laparoscopic and robotic urologic surgery.

Starting from vision of 3D guided surgeries, 4K vision and highly technological transmission system, we tried to offer the participants the most immersive experience possible since from the first editions of our meeting.

Then, thanks to the study of 3D virtual models of the organs derived from standard imaging, we explored many fields, from augmented reality to mixed reality surgery, with the aim to improve planning and intraoperative guidance following the information given by virtual models on the real anatomy, maximizing the surgeon awareness in performing the interventions.

In this tenth year, the surgeons who joined us in the past, will be invited to test once again the newest innovations of the last two years, implemented and enriched in the last months, refined in details and usability, in order to test their duplicability and application.

From augmented reality and 3D virtual models perfectioned as well as the implementation of artificial intelligence we hope to make other steps further the "micro-surgery and automatic image-guidance warning systems.

I'm sure that this special edition of TUM, will be a great success for both the great number of surgical innovative technologies presented as well as for the prestigious faculty of surgeons coming from all over the world.

Hoping that the attendees will enjoy our ambitious program.


